

1. The Scottish Interfaith Council has received funding from the Scottish Executive in each year since 1999 as detailed in the table below.

1.1. The Scottish Executive **has not** specified that any funding should be allocated to constituent groups that belong to the Scottish Inter Faith Council. However, it is open to the Scottish Inter Faith Council's member organisations to apply to any appropriate Scottish Executive funding streams.

The Scottish Executive **has** specified that £141,224 of funding granted to the Scottish Inter Faith Council should be for the particular purpose of the production and distribution of a booklet, "Health Matters" which has been made available to all Health Boards in Scotland.

2. The Scottish Islamic Foundation has received funding from the Scottish Executive since 1ST January 2008 as detailed below. The project being funded will develop a programme of youth work across several partner agencies.

- £10,152 for computer and office equipment
- £5,600 for admin, volunteer and management training
- £200,00 towards the delivery of Islamfest

Total amount paid to the Scottish Islamic Foundation - £215,752
